Uniquely Compelling Allocations FY 2005-2006

1. **Total SAF for 05-06= \$443,390.00**
2. **Uniquely Compelling Funding:**
 - a. Total amount to give for lecture is **2.26%** of total pool of SAF
 - b. Total Amount to be available for allocation **\$10,000**
 - c. One Deadlines- One on October 2nd, 2005
3. **SOFC's Process on 10/3/05:**
 - a. Voted to not allow for late applications, or applications not turned in prior to the deadline to "Uniquely Compelling". This was included on all the publicity.
 - b. Can only fund organizations that were SOAC constituted as of the deadline.
 - c. Reviewed SOFC Constitution Section VIII A a i- which dictates Uniquely Compelling Funding procedures.
 - d. Fund Item- Fully or nothing.
 - e. Discussion of legislation on what is allowed as "an" item- Decided that sets only sold in sets will be funded as an item.
 - f. Read each Budget in random order
 - i. Generated random numbers in Excel and number the emails of the applications
 - g. Reviewed as a group- on the computers!!
 - i. Tallied the total as we when along
 - h. Discussed issues as a groups and established precedent on the process to create fairness between applications.
