VIII. Policies

A. Financial

a. **Uniquely Compelling**

- i. *Organizations that have received Uniquely Compelling funding must wait one school year before reapplying for Uniquely Compelling funds.*
- ii. *No organization may receive more than 30% of the total \$10,000 allotted for Uniquely Compelling, for the purchase of one item.*
 1. *However, an organization can apply for an item whose cost exceeds this cap, provided the organization specifically and definitively indicates how it will cover the extra cost SOFC cannot fund, and meets all other Uniquely Compelling rules.*
- iii. A uniquely compelling grant may only be used for the specific item requested.
 1. In applying for the funds, the organization must clearly state the item they want and where it can be purchased, including three price quotes.
 2. The organization must demonstrate that they have done research to ensure that they have found the lowest price; this must include at least three printouts or cutouts.
 3. The organization must ~~state its purpose and demonstrate how this item will better enable the organization to meet its purpose.~~ *clearly and specifically meet all the “Justification Requirements” as outlined in the Uniquely Compelling request form.*
