

## CG Constitution changes

## Article IV Section 4

- added College Government President's Council

3/22/04

HPC Liaison and Parliamentarian is voted to become two separate positions

- The HPC liaison would be a member of HPC, would serve as Cabinet, and would be a full voting member of Senate.
- The Parliamentarian would be another HP. Her job would be to train all the HPs in parliamentary procedures and to work closely with senators during senator's training and during house council.

New Election Policy for Chief Justice

- Initial pool of Chief Justice candidates is now expanded to include drug and alcohol hearing board members

4/12/04

1. Changes to the duties of CG secretary/treasurer.

- Shall release mini minutes no later than Tuesday noon and full minutes no later than Wednesday noon of the Monday's Senate.
- Shall record minutes for all Cabinet meetings and publish them by noon Thursday of the same week on Cabinet conference.
- Shall post Senate agenda 24 hours before Monday's Senate to the larger community.

2. Appointment of SPEC chair and SPEC chair Training

- SPEC chair will be appointed by the outgoing Cabinet after contact senators are elected in the spring
- She will be trained by the outgoing SPEC chair
- Only senators who have served at least one year on senate are eligible and candidates will be elected by the outgoing Cabinet

3. senator's training.

- It will take place on Monday night at 6:00 p.m. for a minimum of two hours after fall senators are elected
- Topics required to be covered at training – parliamentary procedures by the Parliamentarian, senate boards/senate reports by the Parliamentarian, special interest senators will be trained by previous special interest senators, Contact senator will be trained by previous Contact senators, an introduction of College Government and its function on campus as well as each Cabinet members' duties, and an introduction to the various committees of Senate presented by each head of the committee.
- Each senator will be required to fill out a handout detailing their committee preference and Cabinet will refer to the completed handouts to split all senators into respective committees of Senate, committee training will commence after the first Senate meeting
