Dear Classmate,

Our 40th reunion is approaching: June 6–8, 2008! A harbinger of reunion—and a chance to start nurturing the connections that are the essence of reunion—is our class record book. I hope you'll take a few minutes to let your classmates know your doings and experiences, thoughts and dreams, ups and downs. Here's how:

1. Fill out your personal page. Here, we invite you to share any type of material you'd like—poems, artwork, photos, cartoons, and so on—as long as it fits on a single page **with a one-inch margin on all sides**. You can return it in either of two ways:

- 1) Via the postal service. With this method, you can type or handwrite your page, but please use black ink. You may attach photos or artwork; please note, however, that they will not be returned. Return the personal page, along with your order form, in the enclosed envelope addressed to Joan Schoellner.
- 2) Via e-mail. Go to our class website, <http://www.wellesley.edu/Alum/Classes/1968>. Download the personal page template, save it as a Word file, fill it in (leaving the same one-inch margin all around), and then send it, as an attachment, to: Joan_Schoellner@alum.wellesley.edu. Insert photos if you'd like.

Please note: All photos will be printed in black and white; therefore black and white photos will reproduce best. Color photos with good contrast may also be used, but it would advisable to make a black and white test copy to check whether the final result will be of good quality.

We hope everyone will return a personal page—but, at a minimum, please send a page with identifying information so that classmates will know how to reach you. Also, please take this opportunity to be sure that the College has your latest contact information. There are three ways to do so—call 1-800-339-5233; e-mail updates@alum.wellesley.edu; or edit your directory entry at www.wellesley.edu/Alum/Community.


2. Fill out the anonymous class questionnaire. Please take a few minutes to complete this. Our class portrait will be accurate only if the majority of classmates participate in the survey. To ensure privacy, we do not ask for any identifying information. In addition, all responses will be entered into a computer file and analyzed statistically. This year we are using Survey Monkey, a computerized survey service, to administer and analyze the questionnaire. To respond electronically—which greatly facilitates tabulation—once again go to the class website and follow the instructions given there.

If you prefer to fill out a paper copy of the questionnaire, complete the enclosed copy and return it to Marilyn Averill in the envelope provided. Postage is \$.75.

3. Order a record book. The cost will be \$30.00. Since we'll be printing only enough copies for those who place an advance order, please use the enclosed form to ensure that you receive your copy. Send it, and your check made out to *Wellesley College Class of 1968—Record Book*, in the envelope addressed to Joan Schoellner.

For the personal page, the questionnaire, and the order form, **the deadline is December 22.**
