- Available to alumnae and students (students have limited access to features indicated below)
- Must register with ID number to set own username and password
- There is a SEARCH button at the top right of every Online Community web page that allows searching by any key word within all aspects of the Online Community.
- For the most effective search, click on the  [Help with searching the Wellesley Network](#) link. It is not an easy or intuitive database to use.

- Contains self-entered information about alumnae career and life experiences
- Can search by field, organization, graduate school, major, etc.
- Results sorted by job title
- Allows alumnae to indicate preferences for involvement and affiliation, include descriptions about experiences
- Contact made through blind email

- Students and alums can sign up for permanent forwarding email address
- Username is set when register, remember it is forever
- Forwards emails to whatever service provider you indicate
- Great for students to always be reachable even while moving around
- Must activate to be able to use

- Public forums where students and alumnae can exchange ideas and information about any topic listed or they can create any new topic group
- Where we now house several of our FirstClass conferences to allow alumnae participation and access, including Apartments, Career Fairs, Diversity Career News

- Our Wellesley-to-Wellesley posting site, separate from MonsterTrak and LACN
- Alumnae can enter and search positions as well as post and review resumes
- Can search just for Wellesley listings or search postings from all the institutions that use Harris as their service provider

The Policies In short: no direct solicitations or mass mailings, no password sharing, no abusing the system or we'll lose alumnae and you'll lose access.

The W Network is a database of alumnae who have volunteered to share their experiences and be sources of advice and information for both career exploration and broader life issues. Some alumnae may indicate in the "Areas of Involvement" section of their profiles their willingness to provide mock interviews or help others find a job or internship, but otherwise should not be directly solicited for job, housing, internship or business opportunities, or commercial or political purposes.

The W Network is part of the Wellesley College Alumnae Association Online Community, and is password protected to allow access by registered College community members only. Any sharing or abuse of passwords is considered a violation of the policies for the Online Community as well as a breach of the Wellesley College Honor Code.

The Alumnae Association reserves the right to expel any user and deny further access to the Wellesley College Alumnae Association Web Site and Online Community if such user violates these policies or any applicable laws or regulations.
