

INFORMATION ABOUT SUMMER HOUSING 2008

Transition to Summer Housing Information:

- **The first week of summer housing (June 1 – June 9) is extremely limited**, as the only available halls are Lake House and Simpson West. Room assignments and keys will be available at these temporary housing halls between 8am and 11am on Sunday, June 1st.
- Preference for housing for the first week will be given to those who have registered by April 25th, as well as non-Wellesley students who are here on Wellesley sponsored programs.
- All summer housing students must vacate their '07 -'08 academic-year rooms by noon on Saturday June 1st. Summer housing will be available from Monday June 9th, to Saturday, August 9th in Bates Freeman and McAfee. These are carpeted residence halls.

Summer Housing Information:

Students may move into Bates, Freeman and McAfee **on Monday, June 9th beginning at noon.**

- No student may enter summer housing after the week of July 27th.
- All summer-housing students must vacate their summer rooms and leave campus by no later than 5pm on Saturday August 9th. All residence halls will be closed as of 5:00pm, on Saturday August 9th. If you are approved to return early your name must appear on an early return roster. Otherwise, you may return when all residence halls are open for the fall semester on Saturday, Aug 30th at 9:00am.
- Students who are **(1)** staying in summer housing for the entire summer, **(2)** have registered by the priority deadline and **(3)** who will be living in Bates, Freeman or McAfee during the '08 - '09 academic year *may request* to have their room for the summer.

General Information:

- Eligible registered Wellesley College Summer School students, Wellesley students and '08 Wellesley graduates with no financial holds, and non-Wellesley grant recipients are eligible for summer housing.
- Residence hall storage will **not** be accessible over the summer so please pack accordingly.
- Guests may stay for a maximum of three consecutive days within one week at a time (Sunday – Saturday).
- Meals are not included in rent, however communal kitchens are available and students use this space at their own risk.
- Residential Life staff will be on-call throughout the summer.
- The official billing week runs from Sunday through Saturday, and minimum stay is one week with no partial billing.
Week 1 runs from Sunday to Sunday with no partial billing.
Week 2 runs from Monday to Saturday with no partial billing.

Cost:

- Rent is \$130 per week per person, regardless of occupancy and should be paid directly to the Controller's Office in Green Hall. Rent will be posted directly to your student account.
- Failure to give a full week's notice *in writing to the Housing Office* when changing occupancy dates will result in a \$130 fee. Dates of occupancy must be made known at the time of registration. Students who are only registered for Summer School Session housing are subject to the Summer School refund schedule.
- Students will be billed for the entire length of stay for which they register. It is the student's responsibility to notify the Housing Office directly of any changes in start or end dates.

Registration Timeline:

You may register by sending the form to StudentHousing@Wellesley.edu or returning the form to the Housing Office located on the first floor of the Physical Plant.

Registration forms will be available in the Housing Office and the CWIS beginning Monday, March 13th and priority will be given to students whose forms are returned by Friday Apr. 25th at 4:30pm to the Housing Office in either paper or electronic form.

- Students registered for the entire summer will be notified of the room selection process; others will be assigned spaces.
- When all spaces fill up, students will be put on a waitlist and will be notified as space becomes available.
