ACADEMIC PEER TUTORS (APTS)

Contact Roberta Schotka

- Study skills experts (note-taking, memorization, test preparation and taking, time and task management, communication skills)
- Dorm based. Support academic life in dormitories (e.g. offer learning strategies workshops throughout campus, invite faculty to meals, academic resources for first-years and upper-class women)
- Nominated by faculty, deans, student leaders, APTs, or self-apply
- Trained by the PLTC before and throughout each semester

DEPARTMENT TUTORS

Contact Barb Burck

- Specific discipline based (available for most departments)
- Support students' understanding of specific content
- Three types:
 1. Attached (to a specific course)
 2. Assigned Tutor (for one-on-one tutoring)
 3. Drop-in (available to all students at a specific time and place)
- Each department is responsible for nominating department tutors. The PLTC facilitates hiring and administrative process. Departmental faculty liaison works with the PLTC.
- Trained by faculty in content. Trained by the PLTC in pedagogy and process at the beginning of each semester

PUBLIC SPEAKING TUTORS

Contact Barbara Boger

- Hone students' oral communication skills across disciplines (e.g. oral presentations, Power Point, discussions leaders)
- Offer workshops on public speaking to classes
- Attached, assigned, and drop-in
- Nominated by faculty, public speaking tutor peers, or self-apply
- Trained by the PLTC throughout each semester

WRITING TUTORS

Contact Jeannine Johnson

- Help students develop strategies for writing across disciplines and hone critical thinking skills (e.g. all levels of course writing, senior thesis, internship essays)
- Nominated by faculty, especially Writing 125
- Assigned or drop-in
- Trained intensively by the Writing Program throughout the year. Tutors nationally certified.

All tutors are paid through Wellesley. Students do not pay for tutoring.

Over 50% of Wellesley students use a tutor every semester.
