

# CAMPUS POLICE ALERT



This is a Campus Security Notice intended for staff and faculty members of the Wellesley College community. Please help us distribute this information by e-mailing this notice to friends and colleagues or by posting it on bulletin boards located throughout the campus.

On September 10, 2003 at 1959 hours, a Wellesley College staff member reported that he had been assaulted with a sharp instrument outside of Green Hall.

According to the victim, he was approached by an Asian male, 20-22 years of age, approximately 5'6", wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, green sweatpants and white sneakers. The suspect asked the victim a question and when the victim responded, the suspect reached out and struck the victim's chest twice with the sharp instrument.

Officers of the Wellesley College Police Department searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspect. The Wellesley College Police Department, during the hours of darkness, will conduct steady patrols of the area.

4. If you see a person or witness activity that you consider suspicious, call us immediately at x5555 or use a Blue Light emergency phone.
5. Avoid unpopulated areas, deserted streets, and overgrown trails. Especially avoid poorly lighted areas at night.
6. Trust your intuition about a person or an area. React based on your intuition and avoid areas you feel unsure about.
