Sometime between Saturday, December 2, 2006 and the early morning hours of Sunday, December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2006, a total of four laptops were stolen from Lake House. In addition, a digital camera was stolen from Pomeroy Hall.

The rooms from which the items were stolen were left unlocked. There are no known suspects at this time, but the Campus Police are actively investigating these thefts and encourage anybody having any information to call the Wellesley College Police Department at 781.283.2121.

Also, please read and follow some of the safety tips listed below in order to keep your belongings safe when you are not in your room.

- **Keep your door locked when you are out of your room or when you are sleeping.**
- **Keep valuables locked in a safe place within your room.**
- **Participate in Operation ID and engrave all valuables with your driver's license number or other personal identification.**
- **Record all serial numbers from such items as stereos, TVs, VCRs, etc.**
- **Report all thefts, no matter how trivial, to Campus Police.**
- **Do not lend your keys or OneCard to anyone. This both jeopardizes your safety as well as the safety of your roommates.**
- **Report all lost keys immediately.**
