In light of this morning's news reports of an alleged increased risk of a terrorist attack in Boston this weekend, I want to bring the following information to everyone's attention.

The FBI spokesperson in Boston said earlier today, "the threats do **not** appear to be credible." (my emphasis)

Nonetheless, there continues to be a non-specific general threat of terrorism against our nation, and we all should be on a high state of alert.

The Wellesley College Police Department offers these safety tips for all members of the community:

- Develop a heightened sense of security and awareness at all times.
- Travel with friends, a minimum of 2-3 people together.
- If you must travel alone, be sure to tell a friend where you're going and when you'll return.
- If possible, carry a cell phone.
- Don't do anything that would impair your judgement.
- If you witness anything suspicious, call 911. It is better to err on the side of caution.
