- Every student will have one day to register with her class during this registration period. Online registration instructions can be found at <http://www.wellesley.edu/Registrar/webregistr.pdf>
- The *Look Up Classes to Add* functionality found in the online registration system returns up-to-the-minute enrollment figures. The enrollment figures posted on the Registrar's website are as of 3:00 pm on the day posted.

- You will be able to register for only 4.75 units at this time. Students may add a 5th class during add/drop at the beginning of the semester. First-year students will need to talk with their class dean, Lori Tenser, before being allowed to register for a 5th class.
- The online registration system for the spring 2010 semester will reopen for all current Wellesley students on Monday, November 23 and remain open through Friday, January 8. Students may make changes to their registration during this time.
- If you identify any significant course conflicts, please report them to the Registrar's Office no later than Wednesday, **November 4** so that we can work with academic departments to discuss possible changes. In identifying conflicts, we will consider only those conflicts between courses that would affect a broad base of students, especially those which may affect students with interdepartmental or area studies majors.
