

## **WINTERSESSION 2010 INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS & FACULTY**

Wintersession for-credit courses are available in limited quantity on-campus, off-campus (trips) and through MIT's Independent Activities Period (IAP). Because of on-campus housing constraints, you must have prior permission to stay on-campus in order to participate in MIT courses or have secured off-campus housing.

### **Credit/Non declaration**

If you wish to take a Wintersession course on a credit/non credit basis, you must fill out a card in the Registrar's Office by **January 6**. If you are registered for a Wellesley course taught off-campus we will accept an email sent to the *Registrar Office* account in lieu of the credit/non card.

### **On-campus Courses**

If you take German 101 or Russian 101 during Wintersession, you will need to complete German 102 or Russian 102 in order to retain credit for the first semester's work.
