Description:

This program presents the information needed for employees when responding to a hazardous material release. The level of training is at the First Responder Awareness Level. These are individuals who are likely to witness or discover a hazardous substance release and who have been trained to initiate an emergency response sequence by notifying the proper authorities of the release.

Responsible Agency(s): OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120

Requirements: Annual Training

Provided By: EHS Office

Applicable Departments: Includes staff members in: Custodial, Distribution Center, Maintenance Services, Motor Pool, Science Center staff, Police, and the Power Plant.
