Required Training Program:

DOT - HazMat

Updated 2/14/07

Description: This training applies to any employee of the College who directly affects hazardous material transportation safety. This includes a person who loads, unloads or handles hazmat, marks or otherwise represents packagings for hazmat, prepares hazmat for transportation, responsible for safety of transporting hazmat, operates a vehicle used to transport hazmat.

Training must include:

- General Awareness – *all* hazmat employees
- Function Specific – for those who manage hazwaste, biologicals, etc.
- Safety (ie. hazcom, spill response) – *all* hazmat employees
- Driver Training - hazmat endorsement info under a CDL may apply
- Security Awareness – *all* hazmat employees

Responsible Agency(s): DOT: 49 CFR 100-177, HM-126F

Requirements:

1. Initial Training within 90 days of employment
2. Refresher required every 3 years
3. Written Program: Yes for Security Plan

Provided By: EHS Office

Applicable Departments: Various departments on campus to include Maintenance Services, Grounds, Custodial, Science Center, Post Office, Motor Pool, Health Services.
