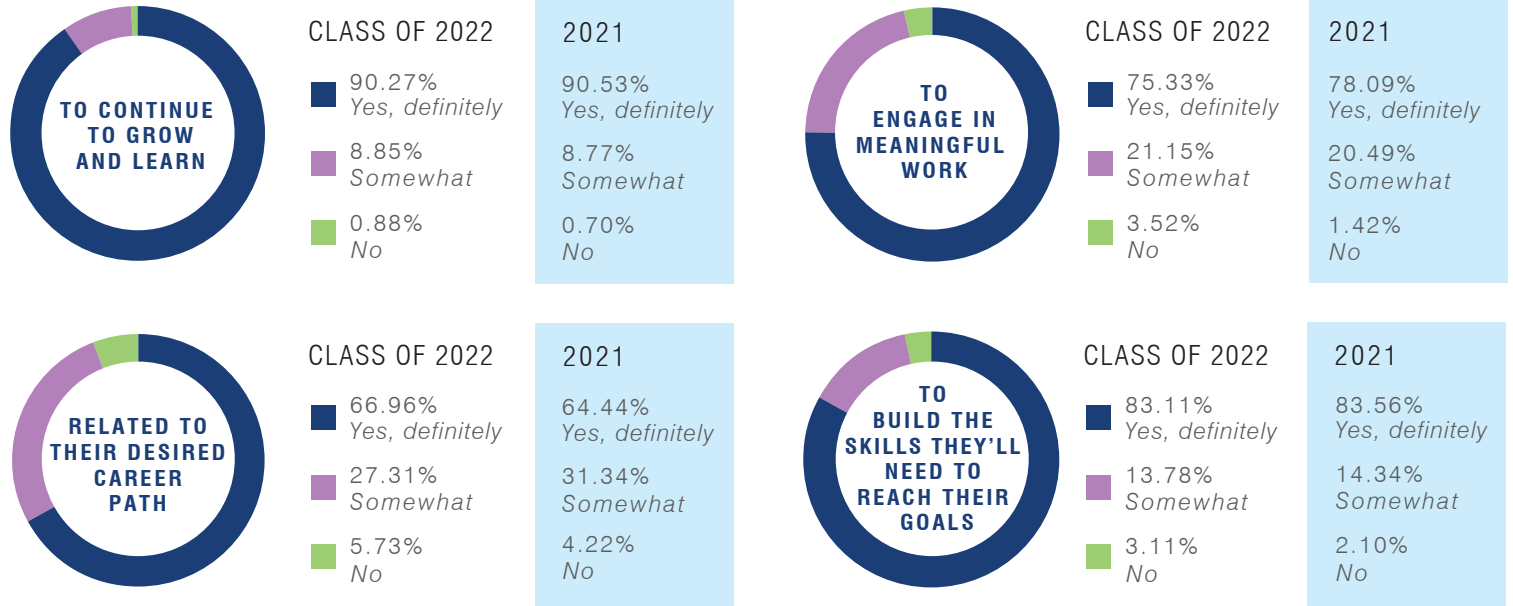

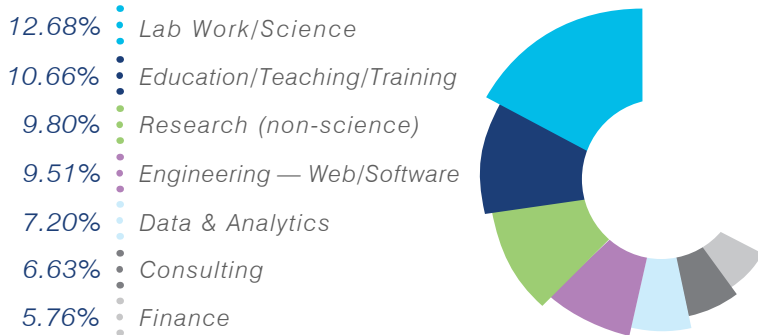
# QUALITY OF *outcomes*

## TOP *job functions*

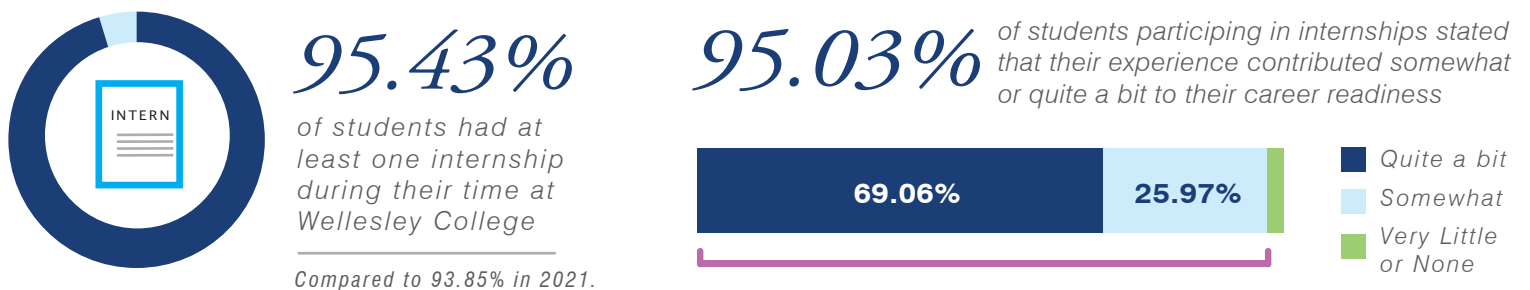
