2018 Summer and Holiday Hours for Administrative Staff Flexible summer hours begin on Monday, June 11 and end on Friday, August 17

The flexible summer work week for full-time administrative employees is 34 hours or four 8.5 hour days. For example, working from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM minus one-half hour for lunch equals one 8.5 hour day. This is the work schedule for administrative staff for summer 2018.

Given the nature of work in some offices, they may decide to be open and fully staffed Monday through Friday. Some offices may decide to participate in summer hours by remaining open 5 days per week with staggered staff. In both of these cases, office hours and staffing needs will be determined at the discretion of the department/division head.
